The Tender Tutor has the **responsibility** to:

- Provide a quality experience which makes children and parents feel important, listened to, cared about, understood, and empathised with
- Give feedback to parents about their child/ren's progress
- (Academic tutoring) Provide an educational experience which is focused on confidence and progress. If a child is not making progress within a reasonable amount of time, The Tender Tutor must make the parent/guardian aware
- Be honest and open if she feels she can not help you

The Tender Tutor has the **right** to:

- be paid in advance of a session
- ask for information before a session so that it can be well prepared
- make a parent aware that progress is affected by irregular bookings
- refuse a client without justification
- be treated with respect
- request to change the date or time of a session if necessary
- alert authorities if a child or parent is deemed to be in serious danger (UK Child Protection)

Your Rights

You and/or your child have the right to:

- expect a high quality service as set out on the website
- expect all personal information to be held in confidence*
- expect to be treated with respect and sensitivity
- be told if your child is not making progress after a reasonable amount of time
- give The Tender Tutor feedback if you are not happy about something, and to have that feedback taken seriously
- rearrange an appointment up to 24 hours before schedule

* Important: The Tender Tutor will never share your personal information with anyone without your permission, as per GDPR rules. **However**, if you/your child express/es that they are in danger, the relevant authorities may be alerted to ensure that they are safe as per Child Protection Guidelines.

* Important : While Angela provides emotional support for children and parents, she is not a qualified Counsellor. Angela has a Diploma in Counselling Children and Adolescents (NCfE Level 5), is a trained Rainbows Facilitator for Children, and has 20 years' experience of working with children and families in UK, overseas, in state and private schools. Your Responsibilities

You and/or your child have the responsibility to:

- book a session at least 24 hours in advance so that The Tender Tutor can prepare your session well
- pay for your session at least 24 hours in advance of the session – sessions which are not paid for will not be held
- provide any necessary information that The Tender Tutor needs to prepare a quality session (academic or emotional)
- be on time – sessions which start late will still end at the same finish time as planned
- remember to attend your session – forgotten sessions will not be refunded
- commit to regular bookings as agreed so that your child experiences incremental and sustainable progress

It is also very important to note that in all face-to-face interaction, **The Tender Tutor is not responsible for the safety of children.** While The Tender Tutor will take every care to look after a child's wellbeing, **parents are still responsible for their children's safety.** By booking, you agree to this condition.
